ON A DAY WHEN A VEHICLE IS ONLY IN-SCOPE OF DOMESTIC RULES

(UNLESS AN EU RULES WEEKLY REST IS DUE)

BREAK UNDER EU RULES

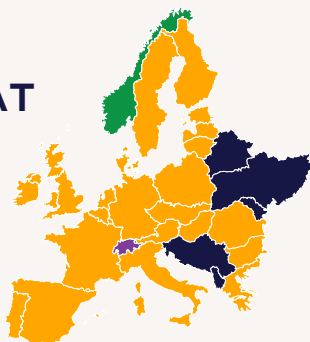
DRIVING UNDER EU RULES

IN-SCOPE

THE MOMENT DRIVING THAT
IS IN-SCOPE OF EU RULES
OCCURS, WEEKLY
REST RULES
MUST BE
OBEYED



OUT OF SCOPE

DURING A WEEK WHERE NO
DRIVING IN-SCOPE OF EU
RULES TAKES PLACE A
WEEKLY REST IS NOT
REQUIRED
